**Reason for change / expected benefits / business case:**

Eurosystem Central Banks in TARGET2 perform the daily monitoring of their community's activity from an operational and business perspective. To do it efficiently, NCBs must have access to the relevant information from T2S about the DCAs opened in their books and this in a timely and complete manner.

During most part of the testing period, the usage of wildcards patterns (\*) made it possible for Central Banks to have the full view of their DCAs on the DCA Balances Search/List Screen for their main monitoring tasks. Due to the fact that wildcards are no longer usable in select boxes, the NCBs have lost the ability to query via U2A the DCA balances in order to obtain the complete view of DCAs under their data scope.

This information is considered crucial for Central Banks tasks in normal (e.g. end of day procedures such as autocollateralisation reimbursement or EoD cash sweep) and abnormal circumstances (e.g. insolvency procedures).

**Description of the requested change:**

NCBs must have the possibility to obtain a complete overview of all DCAs opened in their books in a single screen (e.g. via DCA Balances Search/List Screen) when querying the Cash account balances.

The business rules (e.g. usage rules for wildcards patterns) or the GUI design in the relevant screen should be modified (e.g. removing the mandatory condition in the searching fields (like for the Party BIC) or adding a specific design for NCBs...) to accommodate the NCBs need to have full view of all the DCAs under their data scope in a single U2A query by using the T2S Dedicated Cash Account Balance query.

**Outcome/Decisions:**

- \* CRG on 11 July 2016: During a written procedure from 08 – 11 July 2016, the CRG recommended to launch the detailed assessment on the Change Request.
- \* OMG on 15 July 2016: Following the OMG written procedure from 12 to 15 July 2016, the OMG indicated that the Change Request does not have an operational impact.
- \* Advisory Group on 18 July 2016: In a written procedure from 12 to 18 July 2016, the Advisory Group was in favour of launching the detailed assessment on the Change Request.
- \* CSD Steering Group on 19 July 2016: In a written procedure from 12 to 19 July 2016, the CSD Steering Group was in favour of launching the detailed assessment on the Change Request.
- \* CRG meeting of 6 September 2016: The CRG recommended the approval of the Change Request and its inclusion in the T2S Release 1.3.
